Learner Acceptable Use Agreement

Agreement Scope

This agreement dictates use of Trust IT services and must be signed by all parents / carers on behalf of their child/ren. Parent / carers are expected to disseminate the information within to their child/ren.



The Trust provide learners with increasing access to digital technologies to enhance learning opportunities, increase efficiencies and support well-being. In return, learners must use this technology in a responsible manner. While much of the content may appear self-explanatory, this document outlines a set of basic principles by which all must abide.

My child/ren will:

- Respect and handle equipment with care
- Only use school IT and remote-learning platforms for learning purposes
- Tell a responsible adult if they are having problems with or notice damage to equipment and software

My child/ren will not:

- Use school devices to access any form of personal account
- Save personal files, images or documents to their school accounts
- Try to install or run applications unless permitted to do so
- Try to bypass restrictions or security settings
- Try to access services using someone else’s account
- Share their passwords with anyone else
- Edit other learner’s work without permission
- Engage in online activity which may not be appropriate including sending messages or accessing materials which are not appropriate

I understand that:

- The Trust may monitor my child/ren’s activities when using IT systems and services.
- By failing to comply with this agreement, my child/ren could be subject to disciplinary action in line with the Behaviour Policy. This may mean access is limited or revoked. In the event of illegal activities, this could also include the involvement of the police.
- The expectations outlined in this document apply both inside and outside of Trust premises.

I will educate the young people in my care in the safe use of digital technology and promote online safety as outlined in this agreement.
